GRONDSLAGFASE: HUISWERKBELEID

1. Dit is 'n Fase -beleid.
2. Eenvormigheid in graadgroepe (met betrekking tot raamwerk) is belangrik.
3. Werk wat tuis gedoen word, is vasleggend van aard, nie aanvullend nie.
4. Alle akademiese aspekte word nie elke dag aangespreek nie.
5. Daaglik kan dus 'n aspek van Wiskunde, 'n leesstuk, sigwoorde en klanke of woordbou (Phonics) gedek word.
6. Leesstuk moet op die leerder se vlak wees, vaslegging as doel hê en nie byvoorbeeld 'n navorsingstuk wees nie.
7. Belonings is belangrik – gebruik leeslyste, "sertifikate", ensovoorts om leerders te motiveer om tuis te lees, ensovoorts.
8. Graad 1-3 opvoeders dra tydens Inligtingsaand aan ouers oor wat hul te doen staan met betrekking tot vaslegging van Lees en Wiskunde gedurende die jaar.
9. Graad 1, 2 en 3 leerders kry voorbereide huiswerkvorm wat oor 2 weke strek.
10. Dit is net van Maandag tot Donderdag.
11. Dit word in die "flip-file" gesit (Ouers parafeer daaglik). Gebruik stelsel om leerder te motiveer om ouers te laat teken.
12. **Goue reël** - Huiswerk moet weldeurdag en "min" wees sodat ouers kwaliteittyd daaraan kan bestee en steeds moed en lus het om môre weer tyd daarvoor in te ruim!
13. Maak seker dat alle leesstukke, boeke en/of apparaat wat ouer vir vaslegging in Lees/Wiskunde sal nodig hê, in leerder se besit is.
14. Wiskunde is dieselfde vir Afrikaans & Engelse leerders.
15. Geen huiswerk word tot na die Inligtingsaand gegee nie.
16. Beplanningskediule moet alle tuisopdragte vevat. Maak seker dat die assesseringskriteria sinvol en volledig is.

Dear Parent

FOUNDATION PHASE: HOMEWORK POLICY

1. This is a grade policy.
2. Uniformity in grade groups (with regard to the frame work) is important.
3. All academic aspects are not addressed daily.
4. Work sent home is consolidation and not new work.
5. Daily an aspect of Mathematics, a reading piece, sight, sound and phonics will be covered.
6. The reading piece must be on the learner's level. The reading piece must be consolidation of what has been taught.
7. Rewards are important – use reading lists, 'certificates", etc. to encourage reading at home.
8. Grade 1 – 3 educators will inform parents at the Information Evening, on how reading and Mathematics will be determined throughout the year.
9. Grade 1, 2 and 3 learners will receive a printed homework sheet that covers work for two weeks.
10. It is just from Monday to Thursday.
11. This is filed in their flip file. Parents sign this every day.
12. **Golden rule** – Homework should be on a daily basis and be "minimal" so that parents can spend quality time on homework, as well as encouraging their children to want to do homework!
13. Make sure all reading pieces, books/apparatus that parents will need for consolidation in Reading / Mathematics are with the learner.
14. Mathematics is the same for English and Afrikaans learners.
15. No homework is given to learners until after the Information Evening.
16. Planning must include all homework activities. Ensure that all assessment criteria are accurate and complete.
