

SCROLL POLICY OF EVERSDAL PRIMARY SCHOOL

A scroll is a symbol that is allocated to learners who meet certain requirements/criteria.

AWARDING OF SCROLLS

1. Scrolls are ONLY awarded to Grade 6 and 7 learners.
2. Scrolls are awarded for ACADEMICS, SPORT and CULTURE.
3. The scroll is awarded AS SOON AS the learner has achieved the achievement or meet the specific criteria.
4. The learner only wears the scroll (GOLD or SILVER), which indicates the highest achievement.
5. The scroll must be work on the left-hand side.
6. Sports scrolls' wording is SPORT only. Sports are not specified.
7. If a learner has been chosen for a Provincial team and he/she does not participate, he/she will not receive their golden scroll.
8. Learners who already have a scroll and for a second time met the specific requirements/criteria will receive recognition but will not receive another scroll.

THE CRITERIA FOR SCROLLS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

ACADEMICS

Grade 6 & 7

- Academic average of learners is calculated by the WCED-recording schedules. The schedule processes the SS combined mark and not History and Geography separately.
- A student who has achieved an overall average of 80% or higher for two consecutive terms will receive a SILVER scroll. Two consecutive terms include progression from Gr 6 to Gr 7.
- A student who achieves an overall average of 90% at the end of Grade 6 or for the first time in Grade 7, receives a GOLD scroll.
- Only learners who have already received silver scrolls and qualify again will be recognized during scroll assembly.

SPORT

1. ATHLETICS

Silver : Represented the school's athletics team in at least 2 official athletics events. Participation in the Metro North Championships.

Gold : Provincial – WP, Western Cape and Nationals.

2. HOCKEY

Silver : A Teams: In order to be considered for this award, the player must have played at least five league matches for the A-Team during the season.

Selection for regional teams and participation in at least one tournament.

Gold : Provincial – WP, Western Cape and National.

3. CRICKET

Silver : A Teams: To be considered for this award, a player must have played at least three league matches for the A Team during the season.

Selection for regional teams and participation in at least one tournament.

Gold : Provincial – WP, Western Cape and National.

4. CROSS COUNTRY

Silver : Represented school's cross-country team at 3 official meetings.

Participation in Zone Meeting.

Gold : Provincial – WP, Western Cape and National.

5. NETBALL

Silver : A Teams: To be considered for this award, the player must have participated in at least five full league matches for the A-team during the season. A netball match consists of 2 halves of 15 minutes each.

Gold : Provincial - WP, Western Cape and National A or B Teams.

6. RUGBY

Silver : A Teams: To be eligible for this award, a player must play at least five full matches, during the season, for the A-team. A rugby match consists of two halves of 25 minutes each.

Gold : Provincial - WP, Western Cape and National A or B Teams.

7. CHESS

Silver : A Teams (3 League matches).

Gold : Provincial.

8. SWIMMING

Silver : Swimmers who participated in the Level 2 Championships.
Representatives of the Senior A Swimming Team.

Gold : Any Provincial, National or International participation, as well as level 3 participation.

9. TENNIS

Silver : A Teams: To be eligible for this award, a player must play at least three matches, during the season, for the A Team. A match consists of one set of singles and one set of doubles.

Gold : Provincial (A or B Teams).

(ABOVE-MENTIONED CRITERIA WILL ALSO BE APPLICABLE TO U/14 LEARNERS WHO PARTICIPATED/OR EXCELLED IN HIGH SCHOOL TEAMS).

10. OUTSIDE SPORTS

Gold : Learner who has excelled in any sport for an accredited club at Provincial or National level. Provincial participation's evidence from the accredited club's governing body of the sport in question must be submitted to the Head of Sport.

CULTURE

1. EISTEDDFOD (INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP ITEMS)

Silver : Highest Honours.

Gold : Category winner.

Please note: Unprepared reading is not included.

2. CHOIR

Silver : Participation ATKV final. Eisteddfod: Highest Honours.

Gold : Tygerberg Children's Choir. Eisteddfod: Category winner. Winner: ATKV.

3. MUSIC EXAMINATION: PRACTICAL

Silver : 80-89%.

Gold : Above 90%.

4. MUSIC THEORY

Silver : Above 90% for Gr 1 and Gr 2 Theory Examinations.

Gold : Above 90%, only for Gr 3 or Gr 4 Theory Examinations.

5. BYBELVASVRA

Silver : Regional Participation or Provincial Participation.

Gold : National Participation.

6. EVERDRAMA (No group awards)

Silver : Gold, silver or bronze diploma. (to individual actors as determined by the Adjudicators).

Gold : Best actor/actress and/ category winners. Best supporting actor/actress.

7. ATKV POEMS

Silver : Second place.

Gold : First place.

8. ATKV PUBLIC SPEAKING

Silver : Regional.

Gold : National participation or provincial participation.

9. CULTURE/MUSIC AND OTHER OUTSIDE SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Gold : Provincial Participation. The Governing Body of the applicable activity must send proof to the Head of Culture (Mrs M. Prozesky).

Please Note:

If a learner has received a silver scroll for a specific category, and he/she subsequently receives a gold scroll, the gold scroll must be worn. (Highest achievement).
